THE ENNEAGRAM IN THERAPY

A system of nine personality types that combines modern psychology with traditional spiritual wisdom, the Enneagram is a powerful means to enhance personal development. The specificity and accuracy with which it explains the key dilemmas of each personality type helps focus and speed up the change process.

The Enneagram provides a fundamental basis for working with personal issues, character structure, core adaptive strategies, transference themes, relationship issues, and spiritual and psychological development. It points the way to build upon strengths and to resolve challenges.

The Enneagram gets right to the heart of each individual's core motivation, driving energy and the organization of attention embedded in type structure. It works well with virtually all forms and schools of therapy and change with individuals, couples and groups.



DAVID DANIELS, M.D. is a clinical professor of psychiatry and behavioral sciences at Stanford Medical School and co-author of *The Essential Enneagram* (Harper Collins). In private practice for more than three decades, David has taught the Enneagram system at Stanford, in the community, and internationally for 20 years. He brings his knowledge of the Enneagram to individuals, couples and groups, and to a wide range of applications in clinical practice and the workplace.



TERRY SARACINO, MA, MBA, currently teaches in the internationally recognized Enneagram Professional Training Program with Helen Palmer, David Daniels and Peter O'Hanrahan. She has taught the Enneagram since 1989 as a tool for personal, professional and spiritual growth. She has counseled individuals, designed and taught Enneagram courses specifically for therapists, and facilitated "case presentation" groups for therapists using the Enneagram.

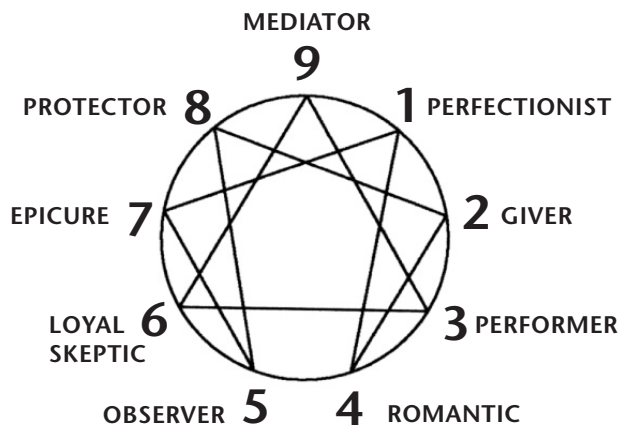
